Because of the three-year funding cycle, some projects that are ultimately approved for funding may not receive any until after July 1, 2019.

Approximately \$16,954,435 will be made available for competitive grants through this RFP for fiscal years **2016-17, 2017-18, and 2018-19**. Only projects in Categories 4, 6 and 8 will be considered for funding in the 9th Funding Cycle.
